Elite Corps Groups are eligible to participate in Fundraising opportunities to raise funds for their individual Corps Fees, as well as the General Corps Fund. Entry into the Elite Corps Groups is tryout-based. Primary Corps is a stepping-stone to Juvenile Corps. Elite Corps Groups attend bi-weekly Baton class, along with Jazz and Ballet.

Tuition payments are to be paid in full during the first week of each month unless special arrangements are made prior to that month. There will be no credit given for missed classes, however **if and when possible**, classes may be made up at a time and day given by instructor.

- ★ Monthly tuition rates have changed to reflect a **nine-month dance season calendar**. In general, rates have not gone up, but have been adjusted to reflect a nine-month payment calendar versus 10-months. Classes will run from September through the second week in June. Monthly payments will be made each month from September through May.
- If your child's tuition has not been paid in full by the end of the current month, a **\$5.00** late fee will be charged to your account immediately. Late fees will increase to \$10.00 per month for each month payment is not received. If your child's tuition has not been paid in full and is not up-to-date by the third month of billing, your child will not be allowed to participate in class(es) until your account is paid up-to-date and the next month's tuition fees are paid in full.
