Corps fees and additional practice times/clinics apply to these groups. Elite Corps Groups are eligible to participate in Fundraising opportunities to raise funds for their individual Corps Fees, as well as the General Corps Fund. Entry into the Elite Corps Groups is tryout-based. Primary Corps is a stepping-stone to Juvenile Corps. Elite Corps Groups attend bi-weekly Baton class, along with Jazz and Ballet.

Tuition payments are to be paid in full during the first week of each month unless special arrangements are made prior to that month. There will be no credit given for missed classes, *however* **if and when possible**, classes may be made up at a time and day given by instructor.
