In 2009, they returned to the championship in Ghent, Belgium, and brought home the gold.

Although the Corps continues to grow, travel, and take on the world, the girls will always remain close to their roots. Performing throughout the community in a number of local parades, corporate and charitable events, the team frequents UW-Oshkosh football and basketball halftime shows and the EAA's annual Santa Fly-In, as well as area nursing homes during the Christmas season.
