Competitive Dancers commit to 2 ½ hours of dance instruction each week broken down into Jazz, Ballet, and Dance Technique. Competitive Dancers *not* in a Twirling Corps are required to take Jazz, Ballet, and Technique. Competitive Dancers must commit to summer classes, choreography clinics, and all performances and competitions held throughout the year.

COMPETITIVE AND NON-COMPETITIVE CORPS GROUPS

CLASS DAY AND TIME WILL DEPEND ON SUMMER COMMITMENT AND PLACEMENT BY INSTRUCTORS. ONCE WE HEAR FROM YOU REGARDING WHETHER OR NOT YOU PLAN ON PARTICIPATING IN CORPS (COMPETITIVE OR NON-COMPETITIVE), WE WILL ASSIGN YOUR CLASS TIMES.

Elite Competitive Corps:

Elite Corps Members commit to the following class times throughout the year, as well as the summer session. Elite Corps members commit to all performances (Parades, Send-Off, etc.) and all competitions including Regionals, State, and Nationals. Corps fees and additional practice times/clinics apply to these groups. Elite Corps Groups are eligible to participate in Fundraising opportunities to raise funds for their individual Corps Fees, as well as the General Corps Fund. Entry into the Elite Corps Groups is tryout-based. Primary Corps is a stepping-stone to Juvenile Corps. Elite Corps Groups attend twice-weekly Baton class, along with Jazz and Ballet.

2019-2020 Julie's Touch of Silver Payment Plan!

Tuition payments are to be paid in full during the first week of each month unless special arrangements are made prior to that month. There will be no credit given for missed classes, *however if and when possible, classes may be made up at a time and day given by instructor.*

- ★ Monthly tuition rates have changed to reflect a **nine-month/36-week dance season calendar**. Classes will run from September through early-June (up until the Recital). Monthly payments will be made each month from September through May.
- If your child's tuition has not been paid in full by the end of the current month, a **\$5.00 late fee** will be charged to your account immediately. Late fees will increase to \$10.00 per month for each month payment is not received. If your child's tuition has not been paid in full and is not up-to-date by the third month of billing, **your child will not be allowed to participate in class(es)** until your account is paid up-to-date and the next month's tuition fees are paid in full.

REGISTRATION FEE

- ★ ***A \$25.00 registration fee will be charged per Student (\$35.00 per family). Registration fees can be paid prior to the start of the session or included with your first monthly payment.***
