- ★ **We will be holding an Open House and registration for all *NEW STUDENTS* August 25th, 26th and 27th at the Studio from 5:00-7:00pm each night. - ★ **Registration Fee:** A \$25.00 registration fee (\$35.00 per family) will be charged to all new and returning students. Registration fees can be included with the first month's payment and are not required ahead of time.

REGISTRATION FOR ALL "ACTIVE" STUDENTS (enrolled within the last six months):

- ★ **All returning students must register for fall classes by August 24th. Online registration is required. *While online registration is available again this year, students enrolling in a class beyond Level 1 must have JTS Staff approval and/or a class recommendation before adding the class. Any student with an account balance from 2025-26 will be unable to enroll online until the balance is taken care of.***
- ★ **JTS Staff will be placing all Competitive Students, as well as students in classes beyond Level 1 (tumbling, tap, hip hop, baton, jazz, ballet).**
- ★ **Registration Fee:** A \$25.00 registration fee (\$35.00 per family) will be charged to all new and returning students. Registration fees can be included with the first month's payment.
- ★ **We ask that all "active" students respond back to us regarding 2026-2027 enrollment (regardless of whether you plan to attend classes or not).**
- ★ **All returning students are invited to attend the *Open House (August 25th, 26th, and 27th; 5:00-7:00pm).***

Elite Competitive Corps:

Elite Corps Members commit to the following class times throughout the year, as well as the summer session. Elite Corps members commit to all performances (Parades, Send-Off, etc.) and all competitions including Regionals, State, and Nationals. Corps fees and additional practice times/clinics apply to these groups. Entry into the Elite Corps Groups is either tryout-based, or dependent on JTS Staff Recommendation. Primary Corps is a stepping-stone to Juvenile Corps. Elite Corps Groups attend twice-weekly Baton class, along with Jazz and Ballet.

Monthly tuition payments are to be paid in full by the 7th of each month. There will be no credit given for missed classes, *however if and when possible, classes may be made up at a time and day given by instructor.*

- ★ Monthly tuition rates reflect a **nine-month/35-week dance season calendar**. Classes will run from September through early-June (up until the Recital). Monthly payments will be made each month from September through May.
- If your child's tuition has not been paid in full by the 15th of the current month, a **\$10.00 late fee** will be charged to your account per week until payment is received. If your child's tuition has not been paid in full and is not up-to-date after eight weeks, **your child will not be allowed to participate in class(es)** until your account is paid up-to-date and the next month's tuition fees are paid in full.
