Holiday Parades

It is our policy to offer parade participation to current students who have had at least one year of baton twirling/combo class instruction at Julie's Touch of Silver. Students currently enrolled in a baton or combo class who have had at least one year of experience are invited to march in the 2017 Holiday Parades! Parade Uniform order forms are now being passed out in class and are also available at the desk. Those marching in the parades must have their own baton. Line-up information and parade details will be communicated prior to the first parade!

Costume Orders, Deposits and Measurements!

We will soon be placing costume orders for the 2018 Recital! Costume order forms will be passed out in class within the next two weeks. Your child's measurements, along with a non-refundable \$50.00 deposit (per costume) will be required by November 20th. This deadline is critical to ensure that your child's costume(s) arrive in time for Picture Day. All costumes are made-to-order and require a great deal of lead-time. Please be sure to turn in costume order forms and deposits on time to avoid late-fees! Measurement instructions will be included on the costume order form. If you are unsure of how to measure your child, a JTS staff member will be able to assist you!

Dress Code and Shoes!

As a reminder, all students must have the appropriate footwear for each of their classes (ie: jazz shoes, ballet, tap, combo slippers, etc.) by the week of October 9th. A list of shoe requirements has been included in this handout – please inquire at the Front Desk with any additional questions!

Please be sure that your student arrives for class in the appropriate attire (leotards, tights, tanks, t-shirts, leggings, shorts). Please do not wear jeans, baggy clothing, dresses, etc. *Additionally, students must wear their hair in a ponytail/bun/braids*. Please do not wear hair "down", as it is distracting and dangerous to the student. This will be the final week that students will be allowed to participate in class without the proper footwear, clothing, hairstyle, etc.
