Individual and Class Pictures are taken by Oswald Photography at the Studio. Oswald will provide photo package options for purchase. Students are not required to purchase photos, but they are a nice keepsake! The Picture Day schedules will be posted in the waiting room and handed out prior to May 5th.

We would like to give students with scheduling conflicts the opportunity to make any *reasonable* requests for your child's picture times. Please email any requests you may have by April 16th. We will make every effort to accommodate everyone's requests. This, however, is not always possible due to the amount of students involved.

Costume Pick-Up Procedure

Many costumes have already arrived... and more will continue to arrive leading up to Picture Day. All costumes will be tried on in class. Students will receive a 'costume balance' form indicating the balance remaining on the costume, along with information about which tights/shoes/accessories to wear with the costume.

Costumes must be picked up at the Front Desk no later than two weeks after they've been tried on. Tuition payments must be up-to-date and costume balances must be paid in order to pick up costumes. Please be sure to pick up your child's costume in a timely manner. As more begin to arrive, we quickly run out of storage space. It is best to take the costumes home as soon as possible to ensure they are not lost/damaged/etc.

Tights, Shoes, Etc.

Please be sure to purchase tights/shoes/supplies at least two weeks in advance of major events (Pictures, Recital, Competitions). Information about which tights/shoes to wear for each costume is included on each Costume Balance Form.

Dress Code!

We would like to re-state our dress code at this time.

Many students have been coming to class in regular clothes (jeans, dresses, skirts), with hair down, no shoes, etc. This is not acceptable dance attire and we will no longer allow students to participate in dance classes without the proper clothing. Students need to be prepared for class the minute they walk into the dance studio. Taking extra time to change shoes, fix hair, remove excess clothing takes time away from learning and is a major distraction to the other students.
